Funding Announcement for the Recreation/Leisure Library in Fundy Shores

Musquash, New Brunswick – Mayor and Council for the Rural Community of Fundy Shores are happy to announce its success in being awarded a grant for \$5620 from the Economic and Social Inclusion Corporation (ESIC) Community Action Fund for the establishment of a Recreation/Leisure Library. This project is to provide inclusive opportunities for sport, recreation, and leisure activities by eliminating barriers to participation while increasing opportunities for active living.

The funding from the ESIC be invested in Phase 1 of the project. Phase 1 includes the establishment of the library and purchase of equipment. Equipment to be available will include: Nordic walking poles, snowshoes, polar skis for strollers, shuffleboard, disk golf, bocce ball, kick croquet and yoga mats, just to name a few. A full list will be published in the coming weeks on www.fundyshores.ca. This is an exciting project to kick off phase 1 of the Recreation/Leisure Library and we look forward to its growth in the coming months. (Additional phases to be announced as funding opportunities arise.)
